Two \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded annually to CSMLS student members who are enrolled in the final year of a CMA accredited Canadian medical laboratory training program. The awards are administered by the Grants and Scholarship Committee of the Canadian Society for Medical Laboratory Science.

Award Guidelines

- Current membership with CSMLS
- Enrollment in the final year of a CMA accredited Canadian training program in:
 - general medical laboratory technology
 - diagnostic cytology
 - clinical genetics

or

- Enrollment in the final year of a full-time Canadian training program in general medical laboratory technology, diagnostic cytology or clinical genetics that has sought but not yet achieved CMA accreditation.
- Canadian Citizenship or permanent resident status
- Members of the Board of Directors and staff of CSMLS, employees of Siemens Healthcare Diagnostics, and their immediate families are not eligible for this award.

Judging Criteria

Scholarship applications will be reviewed by the CSMLS Grants and Scholarships Committee. Each submission will be awarded points according to the following formula, to a maximum score of 100.

- Academic Achievement (30 points)
- Leadership and Volunteer Service (15 points)
- Financial Need (40 points)
- Written Statement of Professional Goals (10 points)
- Two Letters of Reference (5 points)

Application Deadline

Applications and supporting documentation must be received by CSMLS no later than October 1st. Applicants will be notified of the status of their submission no later than December 31st. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Other Information

The names of scholarship winners will be published by CSMLS and/or Siemens Healthcare Diagnostics. A member may only be considered for one Grants & Scholarship Award per year.
