

2023 CSMLS Leadership Development Scholarship

In partnership with the Canadian Association of Medical Radiation Technologists (CAMRT), CSMLS will award up to three (3) applicants the opportunity to attend a leadership development event, in **Ottawa on October 13, 14, & 15, 2023**. This 3-day event is designed to engage members who have demonstrated, at an early stage in their careers, leadership potential and a commitment to the advancement of the medical laboratory profession. The program's objective is to provide young leaders with enhanced skills that will further their professional progress as well as potentially develop new, vibrant and motivated volunteers to draw on for future CSMLS leadership needs.

Participants in the program will:

- learn effective leadership and communication skills,
- learn about their own personal strengths and challenges as leaders and how to adapt their style to work effectively in different group or committee settings,
- learn how to effectively facilitate different types of meetings,
- gain an understanding of leadership within the lab profession, and
- experience national networking opportunities with their peers.

Award Guidelines

- Certified CSMLS member in good standing for a minimum of 2 years
- Have been employed in a Medical Laboratory Technologist or Medical Laboratory Assistant related profession for a minimum of two years and less than 10 years
- Demonstrated commitment to continuous learning and, personal and professional development
- Provide evidence of leadership ability (professional advancement, leadership in the workplace, volunteer achievements, awards, etc.)
- Willing to volunteer with CSMLS or provincial association within 1 year of completing the program
- Canadian Citizenship or permanent resident status and living in Canada
- A member may only be considered for one Grant & Scholarship Award per year.

Judging Criteria

Scholarship applications will be reviewed by the CSMLS. Each submission will be awarded points according to the following formula, to a maximum score of 100.

- Written Expression of Interest (25 points)
- Personal & professional accomplishments (25 points)
- Leadership & Volunteer Service (25 points)
- Professional development activities (25 points)
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Other Information

The names of scholarship winners will be published by CSMLS.

Previous participants of the LDI program are not eligible.
